

## DAY 1: ARRIVAL TO OKINAWA - SIGHTSEEING - HOTEL (B/L/D)

Arrived to Okinawa – Naha International Airport and move to Churasan Beach, box breakfast will be provided, take rest and have free time at the beach. Proceed to Masahiro Awamori Gallery, a factory and showroom of the Higa Distillery showing the manufacturing process of Awamori popularly known as "Sake". You will also get to taste samples of their Awamori. Next have free time shopping at Okinawa Outlet Mall Ashibina, this offers lots of branded items to from local to high end products. Move to a local restaurant and enjoy your lunch. Thereafter drive and visit Ryukyu Glass Village, the largest glass factory in Okinawa. The actual production process of cups and beautiful glasses can be seen here at the same time. After the tour drive to hotel and check in. Dinner will be inside hotel also.

#### DAY 2: SOUTHERN OKINAWA SIGHTSEEING (B/--/D)

After breakfast inside the hotel, start your Southern Okinawa city tour. Move to Okinawa World, a touristy theme park that highlights Okinawan culture. Get also a chance to witness Okinawan Traditional Drum show. And then visit the underground Gyokusendo Cave, declared as a natural monument of Okinawa. Enjoy lunch on your own inside this Okinawa World. After depart and move to Okinawa Peace Memorial Park and Peace Museum which gives a sobering overview of the lead up to the battle, the battle itself and the reconstruction of Okinawa. Drive back to downtown and move to Naha's main street - the Kokusai Dori Street. Enjoy free time shopping to this 2km long alley with varieties of shops including the famous "Don Quijote" and restaurants are lined up on this so called International Street. Then proceed to Dinner will be served at a local restaurant then transfer back to hotel.

# DAY 3: NORTHERN OKINAWA SIGHTSEEING (B/L/--)

Enjoy breakfast inside the hotel. Start your day visiting Cape Manzamo, a uniquely shaped Ryukyu limestone cliff, former coral reefs that have been eroded by the constant waves. Proceed to Onna Purple Tart Factory, a delight place to get yourself treats, specialized in Beni-imo sweet potato with its own distinct flavor and strength. As their factory adjoins the shop, freshly made pastry can be enjoyed and its toothsome flavor and taste will exceed vour expectations. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant. Move to Churaumi Aquarium, one of the best aquariums in Japan. It is also the main attraction of Ocean Expo Park. During your stay, you will also see their talented dolphins with the Dolphin Show. Proceed to Mihama American Village for free time shopping. It resembles a big American outdoor shopping mall with lots of shops, restaurants, and cafes. Dinner will be on your own arrangement. Transfer back to your hotel.

## DAY 4: OKINAWA - NAHA DEPARTURE (B/--/D)

Have breakfast inside the hotel and then check-out. Visit Shuri-jo Castle, served as the administrative center and residence of the Ryukyu kings for several centuries. Next move to Aeon Mall Rycome and enjoy supermarket shopping. Lunch will be on your own arrangement. After this visit Ryukyu Mura a small theme park about traditional Okinawan culture in the form of a recreated village from the times of the Ryukyu Kingdom. Have a unique experience and try your own hand at painting shisa, Okinawan lion dogs! After drive back to Naha and move to a local restaurant for dinner. Lastly, transfer back to Naha airport for your flight back to Manila.
